

But I did hand copy the following on Abbey/Abbey Springs:

*Abbey Springs file*

Santa Fe Daily New Mexican, 1/28/1882, p 3: "Some rich strikes are reported to have been recently made in the Abbey District in the Gallinas mountains. New prospectors are going to the district every day."

Same, 2/10/1882, p 1: The new Abbey Springs Mining District gives evidence of coming to the front. This camp is located about 18 miles northwest of Pueblo Springs and was *discovered in September last*. Some thirty locations have already been made and the new camp is having its boom. The ore has a copper base and the veins are reported large. The ore is reported to run from 20 to 100, ounces silver to the ton. *A new town will be started.*"

Another clip appeared in the issue for 2/5/1882, p 1, but I did not have time to copy it.
