Here is the clip from the Santa Fe Daily New Mexican, 2/5/1882 p 1,
about
mining in Abbey Springs.

"There is no mistake but the boys have a good thing in the Abbey district,
in the Gallinas. Yesterday, we saw on exhibition at Hunning's store a specimen from the shaft now being sunk at the intersection of the Aurora and little Abbey mines, weighing 80 pounds. The prospects of the mine are seemingly as good as any in those mountains. The boys have commenced tunneling in on the vein. Neither wall has been found and they are unable to tell the width of the vein, but it is very large. There are about thirty-five prospectors in the district". (2/5/1882, p. 1)
