

Santa Fe Daily New Mexican, 11/21/1899, p 1: At the White Cap at Rosedale, Socorro County, a 4-foot vein of free-milling ore was struck at a depth of 130 feet. The ore is worth \$23(?) per ton. The owners are Dr. C. G. Cruikshank, W. G. Lane, Jack Richardson, and A. Barr."

Note the value per ton is difficult to read on microfilm - could be \$12 per ton or \$42 per ton -- but if \$12 per ton why bother?
