SUBJECT: Reclamation evaluation for OSM, Gallup Field, Bubany Mine

Bubany Mine 4100' NL, 3000' EL, 10-15-18 Loc. 12

No past history of the Bubany Mine is in my records. The mine is on the Black Diamond bed with a reported 3+ feet of coal. Ownership of the land is not known (Gamerco). At the present time a sealed slope bearing N. 12° E. was discovered. No second opening could be found.

The following photo is presented:

G-4-8 A view showing a filled slope and its dump in the middle background. The depression is piled full of old branches, and the range pole could be poked down about 3'. The photo was taken looking south.

No reclamation is needed or recommended.
