SUBJECT: Reclamation evaluation for OSM, Gallup Field, Gallup West,
Crescent Mine

Crescent Mine 2500' NL, 4700' EL, 28-15-18 Loc. 33

There is almost no information concerning this mine in the literature. Early mine inspector reports stated that the Union mine was to build a tram line to the Crescent mine tipple, which was apparently served by a branch line of the railroad. The mine was opened by a slope and probably ventilated by a furnace. At the present time the site is marked by a mine dump that has been leveled to provide ground space for a store; the reclamation has been done.

The site of the Crescent mine is marked on the map by a cross. No photos were taken, and no work is needed.
